Income	GDP per capita (logged)	World Bank, World Development Indicators	Commonly cited as reason behind prevalence of metal bands, as it implies presence of economic infrastructure as well as disposable income on part of musicians.
Social Globalization	Social Globalization Index (includes such measures as cross-border personal contacts and information flows)	KOF Index of Globalization	Measures social connectivity across borders.
Economic Globalization	Economic Globalization Index (includes measures of trade and global investment as well as relevant state policies in that area).	KOF Index of Globalization	Proxy for increased openness to global economic system.
Democracy	Democracy – Autocracy scores on Polity IV measure	Polity IV	Political rights provide proxy for ability of bands to function without fear of violent reprisal from state.
Physical Integrity Rights	Index of freedom from threats such as torture, political imprisonment, and assassinations.	CIRI (Cingranelli-Richards) Data Project	Absence of state repression of human rights should encourage ability to produce music, even if music is critical of established order.
Fiscal capacity	Tax revenues as a percentage of GDP	World Bank, World Development Indicators	Fiscal capacity is related to better provision of public goods and better government performance.
Worker Rights	Index of respect for core worker rights recognized by the ILO (collective bargaining, acceptable work conditions and wages, prohibitions on child and forced labor)	CIRI (Cingranelli-Richards) Data Project	Worker rights as proxy for steady work schedule plus ability to have vacation time from work; facilitates ability to balance competing demands faced by musicians.
